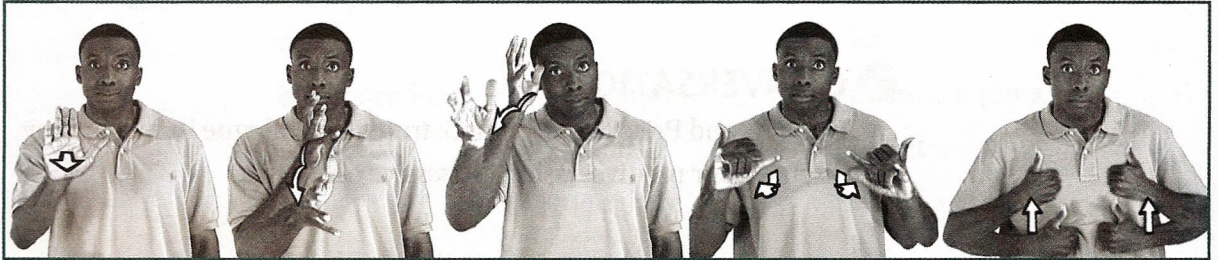


● **Possessive Adjectives**

Minidialogue 3

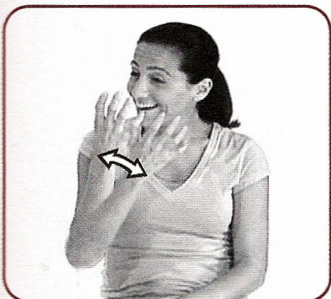
1. Whose cousin are they talking about? That cousin was thought to be what?
