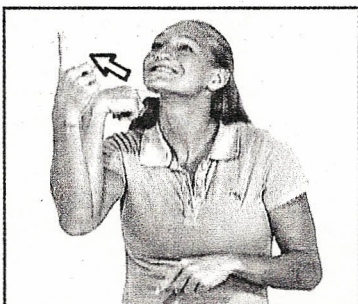

mother to child

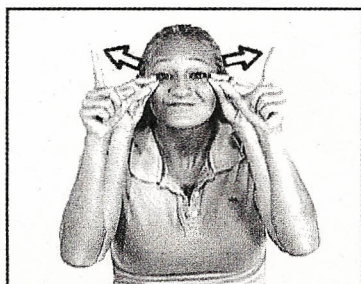

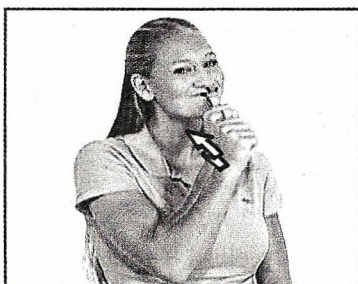

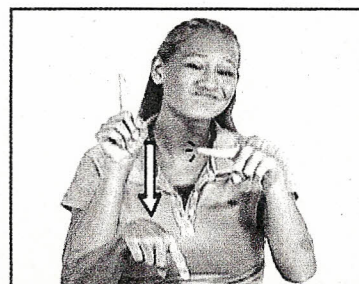
New Signs
